theire charges therein their charges being allowed them I doe give & bequethall unto
them the said Robert Wainwright Thomas Cooper & Thomas Edward thier shillings
a peire of Survaunt English money, to be paid unto them by my Excutrix judicially
after my decease, And I doe hereby utterly revoke & annul all & severall other
former wills & Testaments by me made In witness whereof I have here
unto sett my hand & seale this seventh day of September one thousand six hundred
fiftie five Thomas Marsum, Signed sealed published & delivered in the presence
of W. Halley John Dollman Thomas Thomas.
