by friendly gibe & bequathē unto Elizabeth my most deare & loving wifē Item I do
hereby ordaine & make my said wifē sole executrix of this my last will & testamēnt
Item I do make & ordaine my brother Jacob Marsum aforesaid & my brother in law
Robert Wainwright & Thomas Cooper the younger of Luton aforesaid and Thomas
Howard of Levesworth executors of this my last will & testamēnt and for
theire p̄mises therin thier charges being allowed them I do give & bequathē unto
them the said Robert Wainwright Thomas Cooper & Thomas Howard thirtie shillings
a peice of currant English money to be paid unto them by my executrix immediately
after my decease, And I do hereby utterly rebacke & annulle all & other
former wills & testamēnts by me made In witness whereof I have here
unto sett my hand & seal the second day of September one thousand five hundred
fiftie ffeid Thomas Marsum, signed sealed published & delivered in the presēnce
of W. Hulley John Dollman Thomas Chaynes.

This will was attested at London in the name of Oliver Lord Protector of the Commonwealth
of England at the 24th of October in the year of our Lord 1655 / 66
for the further sealing of wills & granting admis̄s̄ion the same committed to Elizabeth
Marsum his Test̄ & sole executrix etc.
