 and disposing mind and memory (thanks be given unto God for the same) doe make
 and ordaine this my last will and testament in manner and forme following (that is to
 say) First I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of God my maker hoping
 assuredly thro' the only meritt of Iesus Christ my Saviour to be made partaker of his
 everlasting and my body I commit unto the earth wherof it was made to be decently buried
 at the discretion of my executor and executor hereafter named and as touching my worldly
 goods which God hath pleased to bestow upon me I dispose thereof in manner following
 Item I give and bequeath unto Joseph Gutteridge and son of my late son Dunitt Gutteridge
 the sum of thirty pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid unto him by my
 executor or executor hereafter named when he shall attaine unto the age of two and twenty
 years Item I give and bequeath unto Mary Gutteridge my grand daughter and daughter
 of my said son Dunitt the sum of thirty pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid unto
 her by my executor and executor hereafter named when she shall attaine unto the age of
 one and twenty years and if the said Joseph or Mary shall happen to die before they shall
 attaine unto the severall and respective age or ages of two and twenty years and one and
 twenty years leaving no wife or children behind him or her then I give and bequeath his or
 her legacy soe dying unto the survivor of them the said Joseph and Mary but if the said Joseph
 and Mary or either of them soe dying before his or her legacy shall become due and arriv'd ^{leave} a child
 behind them at their decess then I give and bequeath his or her legacy soe dying unto said wife and
 children share and share alike Item I give and bequeath unto Matthew Gutteridge my grandson
 son of my son Matthew the sum of twenty pounds of lawfull money of England to
 be paid unto him by my executor and executor hereafter named when he shall attaine unto
