- 1 devise unto my Son Thomas Marsom All that my Messuages or Tenement or ffarmhouse with all outhouses Backsides and other the appurtenances therunto belonging Situate standing and being in the Hamlet of Stopsley in the parish of Sutton aforesaid together with all and singular the Closed lands Tenements and Hereditaments now used Occupied enjoyed with the said Messuages or Tenement and ffarme or taken reputed or known to be part partall or member therof Now or late in the Tenure or Occupation of Jeffery Winkley his assignee or assignees And also all other my lands and Hereditaments now in the Occupation of the said Jeffery Winkley with their and every of their appurtenances To have and To hold unto my said Son Thomas Marsom his heirs and assignees for ever Upon Condition notwithstanding and paying therout the several and respective Legacies hereunder given and Charged upon the said premises to be paid as hereunder mentioned vizt first I doo give and bequeath unto my Son Nathan Marsom the Sum of One Hundred and Twenty pounds of Lawfull
- 2 money of Great Brittain to be paid unto him by my said Son Thomas Marsom his heirs or assignees Out of the aforesaid Messuages or Tenement ffarme lands and Hereditaments within thine Months next after my Decease and I doo hereby accordingly Charge all and singular the said premises with the payment therof Item I doo give and bequeath unto my Sons Nathan Marsom and Samuel Marsom their Executors and Administrators the Sum of Two Hundred and Ten pounds of Lawfull
- 3 money of Great Brittain to be paid unto them by my said Son Thomas Marsom his heirs or assignees within thine Months next after my Decease out of the aforesaid Messuages or Tenement ffarme lands and Hereditaments and I doo hereby accordingly Charge all and singular the said premises with the payment therof In Trust nevertheless and to the intent and purpose that my Sons Nathan Marsom and Samuel Marsom their Executors and Administrators shall put out the same at Interest upon the best Security or Securities they can get And that all the Interest thereof
- 4 as shall grow due for the said Two Hundred and Ten pounds during the Natural life of my Daughter Martha Wingham Wife of James Wingham shall be paid (by my said Sons and Trustees as they shall receive the same) To and received by my said Daughter Martha Wingham for her own proper Sole and Separable use and benefit and my Will is that the receipt or discharge of the
