 remouing the certainty of my death and the uncertainty of the time when it shall be and -
 being desirous to settle my worldly affairs I do therefore make publick and declare this my last
 Will and Testament in manner and forme following (that is to say) Imprimis I doe give and
 devise unto my son Thomas Marson All that my Messuage or Coundement or farmes houses with
 all out houses Barkides and other the appurtenances therunto belonging situate standing and being in
 the Hamlet of Stobsley in the parish of Luton aforesaid together with all and singular the Closes
 lands coundements and hereditaments now used Occupied enjoyed with the said Messuage or Coundement
 and farme or taken repudie or known to be part parrall or member thereof Now or late in the
 course or Occupacion of Jeffry Wirkley his assignes or assignes And also all other my lands -
 and hereditaments now in the Occupacion of the said Jeffry Wirkley with their and every of their
 appurtenances To have and To hold unto my said Son Thomas Marson his Heire and assignes for
 ever Upon Condition nevertheless and paying therout the summe and recompence Legacies hereunder
 given and Charged upon the said summes to be paid as hereunder mentioned vizt first I doe give -
 and bequeath unto my Son Nathan Marson his summe of One hundred and twenty pounds of Lawfull
 money of Great Brittain to be paid unto him by my said Son Thomas Marson his Heire or assignes -
 Out of the aforesaid Messuage or Coundement farme lands and hereditaments within this Monthis -
 next after my decess and I doe hereby accordingly Charge all and singular the said summes with
 the payment thereof Item I doe give and bequeath unto my Sons Nathan Marson and Samuel
 Marson their Executors and Administratores the summe of Two hundred and ten pounds of Lawfull
 money of Great Brittain to be paid unto them by my said Son Thomas Marson his Heire or
 assignes within this Monthis next after my decess out of the aforesaid Messuage or Coundement
 farme lands and hereditaments and I doe hereby accordingly Charge all and singular the said
 summes with the payment thereof In witness nevertheless and to the intent and purpose that my
 Sons Nathan Marson and Samuel Marson their Executors and Administratores shall put out the
 same at julerest upon the best security or securities they can get And that all the julerest thereof
 as shall grow due for the said Two hundred and ten pounds during the naturall life of my
 daughter Martha Kingham Wife of James Kingham shall be paid (by my said Sons and Executors
 as they shall receive the same) To and received by my said Daughter Martha Kingham for her
 own proper sole and separeate use and benefit and my Will is that the receipt or discharge of the
