and part alike Item. I doe give and Bequeath all my Books of what Manner soever in folio and  
Quarto and all other my Books whatsoever unto my said Thre Sons to be equally divided to &  
and amongst them share and part alike Item. I doe give all my Quirens of what sort soever to &  
my said two Daughters to be equally divided between them Item. I doe give in token of my Love  
to her unto my Sister in Law Joane Southon her Gold Ring which I had upon the overcast of her  
late Brother Mr. Nathan Southon decessed Item. all other my Real Estate not herein mentioned I doe  
purposely leave to descend and fall unto my said Son Thomas Marson and his heire, Item. all the  
rest residue and remainder of my Goods Chattels and personall Estate Not herein mentioned before given and  
Bequeathed I doe give and Bequeath unto my said Son Thomas Marson his paying all my just  
debts that shall be at the time of my death and after payment thereof I do call upon —  
and I doe hereby make and appoint my said Son Thomas Marson Sole Executrix of this my —  
Last Will and Testament And Lastly I doe hereby revoke and make void all former and all  
other Wills bequests and legarises by me at any time heretofore made given and Bequeathed and  
doe make Publish and declare this only to be my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof I  
the said Thomas Marson the Testator have to Earth sealed of this my Last Will and Testament being  
in all four in Number set my hand and to this last Seale and at the top where the Seale and  
affixed together have put my Seal the Twelffe & the day of February anno domini 1722. —
