at his Age of One and Twenty Years by my Exerutiv or Exerutors herein Named out of my
Personal Estate Item my will is and I doe Appoint that my Exerutors do carry on Manage and
Impley in and with the Tanning Trade, the Tanne Yard in Luton aforesaid which I hold by Lease of Mr
Daniel Punter, untill my Son Joseph Gutteridge shall attaine his Age of One and Twenty Years if he
shall so long live. And I doe hereby now Give unto him the said Stake in the Tanning Trade, But doe

Appraised by Two Indifferent persons, Understanding in the said Trade, And if the same Stake (or sure
Valuation as aforesaid) shall fall short of amounting to the Sum of Three hundred pounds in sure

Estate as shall fully make up sure deficiency (But if it Amount to more than Three hundred
pounds I doe will and Appoint my said Son Joseph to pay sure Overplus to my Exerutors for

Son James Gutteridge the Sum of Two hundred pounds of Lawfull money of Great Britain to

Smith wife of Thomas Smith (my three Children by my former wife) the several Sums of
Thirty pounds a peere, to be paid unto them respectively within Twelve Months next after my
Decease Upon this Condition that they and every of them doe respectively Release and discharge my Exerutors
(Some time before the time mentioned for the payment of the said last Named Legacies) of and
from all sure Sum and Sums of Money and Legacies respectively Given to them in and by the
