When these maps were first accessioned, some Mid-Beds maps were already marked with plan numbers. These numbered maps were catalogued under WAV references 15-85, roughly corresponding with the existing map numbers. The remaining Mid-Beds maps, which did not have plan numbers, were allocated references WAV 86-111.

Later analysis has shown that the numbered maps were working maps annotated to record how the land was being used throughout the war period, and the numbering was merely a recording device used by the surveying company. The unnumbered maps illustrated which fields had been ploughed or drained or reseeded by Order.

During recataloguing, these two separate sets of Mid-Beds maps have been combined and listed in alphabetical order by parish, and are referenced WW2/AC3/1-107.

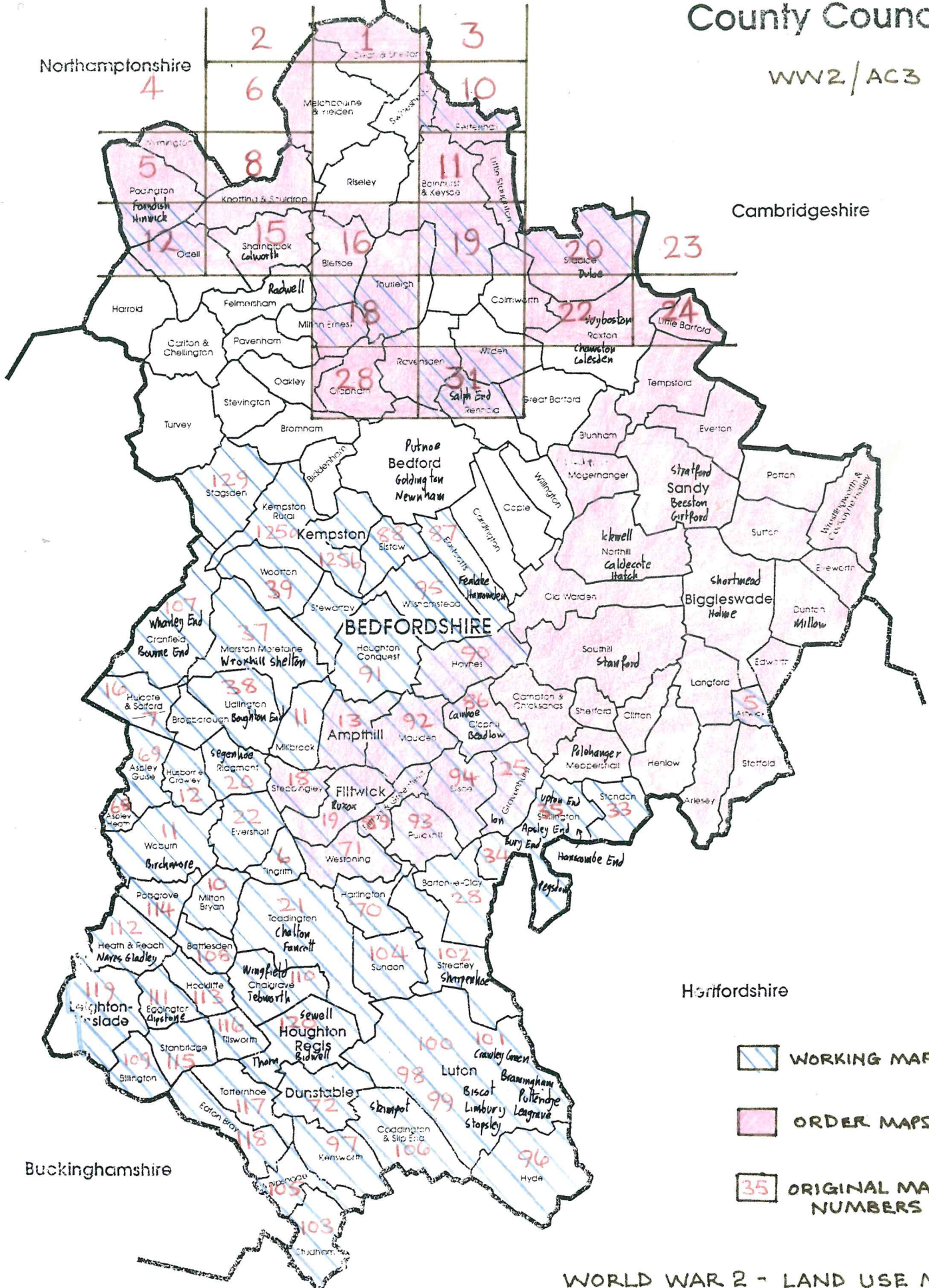
The North Bedfordshire series

The North Bedfordshire maps were unnumbered when they were accessioned and were all catalogued under one reference: WAV 115. These have now been recatalogued individually, in alphabetical order by parish under references WW2/AC3/108-136.

The typed lists which were originally referenced WAV 112-114 have been weeded out and no longer exist.
